### MRc4 – Recycled Content

SkyPly is constructed with various core materials. Composite cores contain recycled content while veneer cores do not. The percentage of recycled content is dependent upon the core type and the thickness of the panel. In order to provide the most accurate documentation, please contact our Sustainability Specialist with detailed information about your product to receive a customized letter for LEED documentation.

**NOTE:** SkyPly Veneer Core Panels do not contain any recycled content.

### MRc5 – Regionally Manufactured/Harvested

### MRc7 – Certified Wood

SkyPly can be purchased with the option of FSC® Mix Credit Certification. FSC Mix is valued at 100% FSC for LEED MRc7. You must specify FSC Certified SkyPly when ordering.

**NOTE:** Your supplier's invoice is the approved LEED documentation needed to support this credit. It will state the FSC certification claim and the supplier's Chain of Custody number.

### IEQc4.4 – Low-emitting Composite Wood

SkyPly Hardwood Plywood is an Ultra-Low-Emitting Formaldehyde (ULEF) product that is CARB ULEF Exempt under California Executive Order N-14-038. This meets the more stringent criteria for Low-emitting materials in LEED v4.
